BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission has received an invoice dated July 2, 2007, from Harding & Shultz for costs associated in the above-captioned docket, totaling \$2,348.60. Commission staff has reviewed the invoice and found it to conform to the Agreement for the Base Public Advocate Services dated November 15, 2004, subsequently amended, between the Commission and Harding & Shultz. Commission staff recommends the Commission approve assessment of the expenses reflected on the invoice from Kinder Morgan, Inc., n/k/a SourceGas Distribution LLC (Source-Gas), pursuant to Neb. Rev.
