BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 24, 2007, pursuant to a July 16, 2007 request received from Nebraska Resources Company, LLC (NRC), the Commission opened this investigation on its own motion to investigate jurisdictional issues pertaining to the construction and operation of a natural gas pipeline within the state.

The order stated that any person wishing to become a party to this proceeding shall do so by filing a Petition for Intervention or a Protest within the time specified in the Commission Rules of Procedure, Neb. Admin. Code Title 291, Chapter 1. Pursuant to the July 24, 2007 order, Nebraska Resources Company LLC and Cornerstone Energy each filed a Petition for Formal Intervention on August 21, 2007, and August 23, 2007, respectively.

The Commission finds that the Petitions for Formal Intervention should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commission that Nebraska Resources Company LLC's and Cornerstone Energy's Petitions for Formal Intervention shall be and are hereby granted.
