By application filed April 10, 2008, Coral Energy Resources, L.P. (Coral), Houston, Texas, seeks authority to change its name to Shell Energy North America (US) L.P. (SENA). Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 14, 2008.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant received authority to operate as a Certificated Natural Gas Provider November 20, 2007. No formal or departmental complaints are pending against applicant.

Applicant requests authority to change its name to Shell Energy North America (US) L.P. (SENA). The proposed name change will not affect the company's financial, technical, or managerial capabilities. Applicant has received authority from the Nebraska Secretary of State to use the name Shell Energy North America L.P.

Based upon the information provided in the application and by affidavits, the Commission finds that the provisions of *Neb. Rev. Stat.* §§ 66-1848, 66-1849 and applicable Commission rules and regulations are met. Coral's application for authority to change its name should be granted.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for authority is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made, the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service as a competitive natural gas provider as Shell Energy North America (US) L.P.


