BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 10, 2012, the Commission was notified by letter from CenterPoint Energy Services, Inc. (CenterPoint) that CenterPoint wishes to withdraw the certificate originally granted to Asgard Energy LLC (Asgard).

Asgard was granted authority as a competitive natural gas provider (CNGP) on February 3, 2009, in the above-captioned docket. On November 29, 2011, the Commission recognized that CenterPoint had acquired the certificate of Asgard. CenterPoint also holds a CNGP certificate, granted July 9, 2007, in Application No. NG-0049. CenterPoint indicates that for the time period July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012, no sales required to be identified in an annual report to the Commission were made.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction pursuant to  $Neb.\ Rev.$  Stat. sections 66-1848 to 66-1849 (2003 Supp.).

The request to withdraw authority should be granted, and the certificate originally granted to Asgard should be of no further force or effect.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of authority originally issued to Asgard Energy LLC as a competitive natural gas provider on February 3, 2009, is of no further force or effect.
