BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 5, 2010, NorthWestern Energy, Sioux Falls, South Dakota filed its 18th Revised Sheet No. 7.1 of NorthWestern's Gas Tariff which included its updated gas cost adjustment (GCA) effective for meter readings on and after November 2, 2010. NorthWestern states that based upon the change from an exclusive supplier agreement to an Asset Management Agreement, NorthWestern will have the opportunity to purchase gas at various points along the interstate pipeline from a variety of suppliers. The utility further states that the change will require personnel dedicated to the management of supply under the contract. NorthWestern also states that it intends to include in its April 2011 GCA the accumulated costs related to the salary and benefits for the employee.

Although not specifically set forth in the filing, it is clear that NorthWestern seeks Commission approval to include these costs in its April filing. Therefore we have treated the filing as an application seeking approval of the Commission on the narrow question of whether the inclusion in the GCA of the salary and benefits of the employee needed to manage supplies under the new agreement until the next general rate filing is permissible.

The Commission finds that it may be necessary to assess certain expenses associated with this docket to NorthWestern, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 66-1840. The Commission hereby provides notice to the utility, as required by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 66-1840, that expenses may be assessed.

The Commission further finds that a hearing on the matter shall be scheduled for **December 1, 2010, at 1:30 p.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 the Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
