The Commission has received a letter dated November 12, 2015, from Baylor Evnen and an invoice from Blue Ridge Consulting Services, Inc. (Blue Ridge) for costs associated with the above-captioned docket, totaling \$4,047.50. Commission staff has reviewed the invoice and found it to conform to the Agreement dated May 2, 2014, between the Public Advocate and Blue Ridge.

Commission staff recommends the Commission approve assessment of the above-described invoice in the amount of \$2,386.25, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. \$ 66-1840.
