BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission has received an invoice dated June 13, 2014, from Christensen Associates Energy Consulting (Christensen) for costs associated with the above-captioned docket, totaling \$3,076.94. Commission staff has reviewed the invoice and found it to conform to the Agreement dated May 12, 2014, between the Nebraska Public Service Commission and Christensen.

Commission staff recommends the Commission approve assessment of the above-described invoice in the amount of \$2,847.86, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 66-1840. The remaining balance represents charges accrued prior to the allowed date of assessment pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 66-1840(1) and will be paid from the quarterly assessment pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 66-1841.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Upon the recommendation of the Commission staff, the Commission finds that assessment from SourceGas of the expenses reflected in the above-mentioned invoice from Christensen Associates Energy Consulting should be approved for the amount of \$2,847.86. The Commission further finds that the Commission should pay the invoice upon receipt of payment by SourceGas.

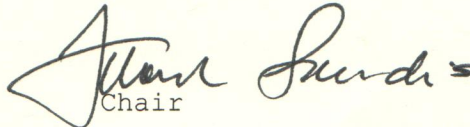
O R D E R

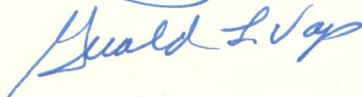
