The Commission has received an invoice dated November 9, 2015, from Christensen Associates Energy Consulting (Christensen) for costs associated with the above-captioned docket, totaling \$6,538.00. Commission staff has reviewed the invoice and found it to conform to the December 10, 2014 Agreement, Exhibit B dated June 11, 2015, between the Nebraska Public Service Commission and Christensen.
