## BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 20, 2018, the Nebraska Public Service Commission opened a docket seeking to investigate the effects of the federal Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, Public Law No. 115-97, upon all natural gas public utilities subject to the Commission's jurisdiction under the State Natural Gas Regulation Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 66-1801 - 66-1868.

A Petition for Formal Intervention was filed by the Nebraska Public Advocate on March 29, 2018. A Petition for Formal Intervention was filed by the City of Grand Island on April 17, 2018.

Pursuant to the Rules of Commission Procedure, 291 Neb. Admin. Code § 1-015.01 et seq., I find that the above-listed petitions for formal intervention should be granted, and the Nebraska Public Advocate and the City of Grand Island should be designated as formal intervenors and parties to this proceeding. The Nebraska Public Advocate and the City of Grand Island further should be entitled to participate in the proceeding to the extent of their express interest in the matter and in a manner consistent with 291 Neb. Admin. Code § 1-015.01C.
