## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 21, 2009, an application was filed by Metropolitan Utilities District of Omaha (Applicant), Omaha, Nebraska, providing notice as required by  $Neb.\ Rev.\ Stat.\ \S\ 66-1863(1)$  (Cum. Supp. 2006), of its intent to extend or enlarge its service area or extend a gas main.

The Commission sent notice on October 22, 2009, by U.S. Mail to Metropolitan Utilities District of Omaha that protests or formal interventions must be filed on or before November 12, 2009. The Commission also posted notice of the application on the Commission website on October 21, 2009.

No protests or petitions for intervention were filed. Therefore, pursuant to  $Neb.\ Rev.\ Stat.\ \S\ 66-1863(3)$ , the proposed enlargement or extension is presumed to be in the public interest and Applicant may proceed with the extension or enlargement without further Commission action.
