BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 11, 2005, the Commission entered an order approving costs associated with the second stage of intertandem trunking connecting the Qwest tandem located in Council Bluffs, Iowa to the Alltel tandem located in Lincoln, Nebraska. The Commission approved costs to Alltel for providing intertandem trunking described above in the amount of \$77,979.00. However, the Commission inadvertently omitted initial installation charges in the amount of \$1,394.16.

The Commission therefore finds that its order entered January 11, 2005, should be amended to approve payment of \$1,394.16 to Alltel for installation charges related to intertandem trunking.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that its January 11, 2005, order is amended to also approve installation charges of \$1,394.16.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon invoice from Alltel \$1,394.16 in installation charges related to intertandem trunking shall be paid by the Wireless Enhanced 911 Fund.
