OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Commission opened the present docket on September 28, 2004 in order to investigate whether Fast Phones of Nebraska (Fast Phones) unnecessarily remitted payments to the Wireless Enhanced 911 Fund. Based upon information supplied to the Commission by Fast Phones, the Commission has determined that Fast Phones unnecessarily remitted payments to the Fund totaling \$431.00 from July 2002 through July 2004.

Commission Staff and Fast Phones have entered into a stipulation to resolve the investigation. Fast Phones and Commission Staff agree that in exchange for repayment of the \$431.00 to Fast Phones, Fast Phones waives its right to hearing on the matter. The Commission finds that the stipulation should be approved and that a refund in the amount of \$431.00 should be paid from the Fund to Fast Phones.

The Commission further finds that no further investigation on this matter is necessary and that this docket should be closed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Fast Phones shall be refunded \$431.00 in overpayments made to the Wireless Enhanced 911 Fund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no further investigation on this matter is necessary and this docket shall be and is closed.
