OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened this docket on its own motion June 6, 2006, seeking to establish audit requirements related to the Wireless Enhanced 911 Fund. On April 10, 2007, the Commission entered an Order adopting remittance policies and establishing a waiver mechanism for certain qualifying carriers. On July 31, 2012, the Commission entered an Order amending the audit policy and waiver mechanism with respect to the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund.

This Order addresses the late-filed waiver request filed by Americatel Corporation (NE000029) for the audit due on December 31, 2015. The Commission finds that the late-filed waiver request received for Americatel Corporation should be accepted.

In addition, Commission staff reviewed the waiver request to determine whether the request met the Commission's conditions for a waiver. Based upon that review, Commission staff recommended that the Commission grant the waiver request filed by Americatel Corporation. The Commission finds that Americatel Corporation has met all criteria established by the Commission in its July 31, 2012 order. The Commission finds that the late-filed waiver request should be granted for the E911 remittance audit otherwise due on December 31, 2015.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the late-filed waiver request filed by Americatel Corporation related to the E911 remittance audit due on December 31, 2015, is granted.
