BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 23, 2010, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) entered an order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-465(1)(e) adopting a permanent funding mechanism and process to provide funding for the implementation and provision of enhanced 911 service. Subsequently, the Commission entered Progression Order No. 1, which in part, amended the eligible expenses for wireless service providers in Section IIB of the order. Due to a clerical error certain language was omitted. The Commission finds that an order nunc pro tunc should be entered to correct the paragraph to read as follows:

II. Clarifications Regarding Wireless Service Provider Funding

B. Eligible Expenses

The Commission has reconsidered the list of eligible expenses for wireless service providers. Eligible expenses may include administrative expenses directly related to the provision of enhanced wireless 911 service not to exceed rates previously approved and paid by the Commission in Docket No. 911-022. Documentation in support of the expenses will be required as with all other expenses at the time of the annual verification.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that an order nunc pro tunc to correct the clerical errors set forth herein.
