OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened the above-captioned docket, on its own motion, to implement provisions of LB 1222 [2006] and to establish a permanent funding mechanism for wireless enhanced 911 service.

LB 1222 requires that the Commission:

Establish a mechanism for determining the level of funding available to each public safety answering point and wireless carrier for costs determined to be eligible by the commission....

Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-465(1)(e) (2006).

In establishing the funding mechanism, the Commission is in the process of developing a cost model. As part of that effort, we are seeking input from the Wireless Enhanced 911 Advisory Board as well as all affected parties including PSAPs, wireless carriers, local exchange providers, and third-party vendors. In order to accomplish this, the Commission hereby schedules a workshop for April 16, 2007, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., in the Atrium Conference Room, 1200 N Street, Suite #206, Lincoln, Nebraska, to review elements of the cost model.
