## BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On June 10, 2008, Jeff Pursley, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (Complainant) filed a complaint against the above-captioned Respondents alleging violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-437 (Cum. Supp. 2004).
