BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 13, 2007, the Nebraska Public Service Commission approved funding for maintenance of equipment necessary for the implementation of enhanced wireless 911 service. The Commission approved funding of **\$32,902.68**, for Evergreen software maintenance and **\$22,013.94**, for hardware maintenance, paid in annual installments for a period of up to five (5) years commencing July, 2007. Each was to provide maintenance over five (5) years after the first year warranty period.

Pursuant to the order entered by the Commission on October 21, 2008 in Docket No. 911-037/PI-140, the annual installments paid for software maintenance must be amended. Therefore, the Commission finds that the funding in the amount of **\$32,902.68** for software maintenance, shall be paid in annual installments over a period of four (4) years in the amount of **\$8,225.67** per year.

Approval of these recurring costs is subject to the limitations set forth herein and the terms of the contract, subject to change based upon the availability of funding and the permanent funding mechanism.

The Commission reserves the right to modify any recurring costs associated with this funding request, including any approved amounts for maintenance, consistent with amendments to the Interim Policy or the establishment of a permanent funding mechanism.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund shall pay to Chase County or its designee the amount of **\$32,902.68** for software maintenance, to be paid in annual installments over a period of four (4) years in the amount of **\$8,225.67** per year, subject to the conditions and limitations set forth herein.
