BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission has previously approved funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses of implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service related to enhanced services for wireless carriers.

Washington County has one public safety answering point (PSAP), which will provide enhanced wireless 911 service throughout Washington County. The local exchange carrier serving Washington County's PSAP is Qwest.

Washington County entered into a service agreement with Qwest for enhanced wireless 911 equipment and services. A copy of the agreement has been provided. In the agreement, Washington County authorized the Commission to remit all payments for enhanced wireless 911 service to Qwest.

The Commission has previously approved payments on behalf of Washington County for Phase I LEC services for certain wireless carriers. Initial costs are for database upgrades, trunking infrastructure and purchase, installation, and testing of circuits for enhanced wireless 911. Recurring costs are monthly fees for database management and for operation and maintenance of trunks and circuits.

Since the approval, Verizon has acquired Alltel Wireless. Therefore, Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, must be amended to reflect the proper carriers and to comport with the invoices from Qwest beginning with the billing period from Feb 28 to March 27 and continuing until such time as payments to Qwest are changed pursuant to the permanent funding mechanism and process adopted in Docket No. 911-019/PI-118.

The Commission therefore finds that Appendix A should be amended to reflect the appropriate wireless carrier.

Information set forth in Appendix A shall be treated as proprietary and confidential.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Appendix A shall be amended to reflect the appropriate wireless carrier.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission shall remit to Qwest amounts that comport with Appendix A attached hereto.
