BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 13, 2007, an order approving funding in part was entered. Due to a clerical error, the order stated that Dawes County sought non-recurring costs in the amount of \$171,712.89 for the purchase and installation of equipment necessary to implement enhanced wireless 911 service. The order should have stated that Dawes County sought non-recurring costs in the amount of \$116,796.27.

The Commission finds that the March 13, 2007 order in the above captioned docket should be amended to correct the clerical error.

Additionally, the order stated that Dawes County's request included costs associated with the first year of maintenance and service. However, the Dawes County request actually sought **\$32,902.68** over five (5) years for software maintenance and **\$22,013.94** over five (5) years for hardware maintenance.

As stated in the March 13, 2007 order, the Commission finds that maintenance of the equipment and software is essential to ensure the proper operation of the statewide 911 system and should be funded to the extent funds are available during this interim period. Therefore the Commission amends its previous order with respect to payment of maintenance costs as follows.

Therefore, the request for funding regarding maintenance should be granted in the amount of **\$32,902.68** paid in annual installments over five (5) years for software maintenance and **\$22,013.94** paid in annual installments over five (5) years for hardware maintenance subject to the limitations set forth herein and in the previous order.

The Fund shall pay **\$10,983.32** to Dawes County annually for a period of five (5) years for software and equipment maintenance, subject to change based upon the availability of funding and the permanent funding mechanism. Dawes County may request that these amounts be paid directly to the vendor.

Those provisions of the March 13, 2007 order not specifically amended herein remain in effect.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that that the March 13, 2007 order in the present docket should be amended as described herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Fund shall pay **\$10,983.32** to Dawes County annually for software and equipment maintenance consistent with the terms of this order and the amounts set forth in Appendix A.
