BY THE COMMISSION:

On or about April 15, 2008, Saline County Public Safety Answering Point, and Crete Police Department (Saline County) filed a funding request seeking **\$5,025.00** for a mapping software conversion.

The Enhanced Wireless 911 Advisory Board (Advisory Board) considered this and similar funding requests at three Advisory Board meetings. It was represented at these meetings that the conversion would be done due to changes in the software platform. However, it was further advised that the conversion would not be immediately necessary.

Further discussion regarding the request was held at the Advisory Board's April 21, 2008 meeting and the Advisory Board recommended that Saline County's request be denied. The Commission has not paid for similar conversions for other PSAPs.

A hearing was held on the request on July 29, 2008. No one appeared on behalf of Saline County regarding the funding request. The Commission finds that the funding request should be denied.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the funding request for map software conversion submitted by Saline County, is denied.
