BY THE COMMISSION:

On or about February 23, 2009, the City of Lincoln/Lancaster County, Public Safety Answering Point (Lincoln/Lancaster County) filed a funding request seeking approval for costs for equipment and software necessary for the provision of enhanced wireless 911 services to be paid from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund (Fund).

Lincoln/Lancaster County had previously requested that the request be suspended. Subsequently, Lincoln/Lancaster County asked that it be placed on the agenda of the Enhanced Wireless 911 Advisory Board (Advisory Board) for its consideration. The Advisory Board considered the request at its November 2, 2009 meeting and recommended funding be approved for ten (10) of the fourteen (14) positions requested. Lincoln/Lancaster County has since provided revised costs based upon the Advisory Board's recommendation and has requested that the Commission approve 100% funding for the equipment. The Fund previously provided 100% funding for equipment for this PSAP.

Based upon the above, the Commission finds that this matter should be set for hearing on **January 12, 2010 at 1:30 p.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
