BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

By written requests for funding received from KBRC Regional E-911 (KBRC) seeks funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund (Fund) for equipment, software and maintenance necessary for the implementation and provision of Phase II wireless enhanced 911. KBRC covers Brown, Cherry, Keya Paha and Rock Counties.

In its application, KBRC seeks non-recurring costs totaling **\$388,535.00** for the purchase and installation of equipment and software necessary for enhanced wireless 911 service in each of the following counties: Brown, Cherry, and Keya Paha. Additionally, KBRC seeks funding for five (5) years maintenance on software totaling **\$43,812.00** paid in five (5) installments and five (5) years maintenance on equipment totaling **\$154,680.00** paid in four (4) annual installments to the vendor for all of the above-listed counties.

A hearing on this matter is scheduled to occur on **November 10, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. CDT** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. Parties have requested a video location.
