# OPINION AND FINDINGS

On or about August 8, 2006, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened the above-captioned docket, on its own motion, to develop policies and process requests for access to GIS data and the GIS Repository.

In an order entered on August 30, 2005, in docket No. 911-011/PI-97, the Commission approved the development of proper GIS data and map databases for public safety answering points (PSAPs) or supplementation of existing map databases necessary for Phase II service. The Commission has since approved funding for the development of GIS data for several PSAPs.

On April 4, 2006, the Commission also approved funding for a centralized data repository (Repository) for the GIS data, in order to allow for maintenance of the data and access to the data by individual PSAPs and the Commission.

On April 9, 2013, the Commission approved an amended GIS Data Repository Access and Use Policy and a procedure for entities to request access to the Repository.

On January 8, 2008, the Commission granted GeoComm's request for access to the Repository for 911 purposes for GIS data for 33 Nebraska Counties.

On August 14, 2012, the Commission granted GeoComm's request to amend its access to the Repository for 911 purposes to include GIS data for Johnson and Pawnee Counties.

On August 6, 2013, the Commission-granted GeoComm's request to amend its access to the Repository for 911 purposes to include GIS data for Keith County.

On or about May 11, 2017, GeoComm submitted a request to amend its access to the Repository for 911 purposes to include GIS data for the entire State of Nebraska. The Commission finds

that the request should be granted and the existing password expanded to allow access to the additional data.

GeoComm shall abide by the Commission GIS Access and Use Policy, attached hereto as Appendix A. Failure to do so could result in a loss of access to the Repository. The Commission reserves the right to amend the Policy at any time.

The Commission does not warrant the accuracy or completeness of the data maintained in the Repository.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that  ${\tt GeoComm's}$  application for amended access to the GIS Repository is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that  ${\tt GeoComm}$  shall be bound by the  ${\tt Commission's}$   ${\tt GIS}$  Access and  ${\tt Use}$   ${\tt Policy}$  attached hereto as Appendix A as may be amended.
