O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On or about November 5, 2008, Sue Vanicek, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS) (hereinafter "Complainant") of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) filed a Complaint against Consumer Cellular, Inc., Portland, Oregon (hereinafter "Respondent") alleging that Respondent failed to timely file with the Commission its quarterly report(s) due October 15, 2008 as required by § 86-459(2). On January 6, 2009, the Commission entered an order setting hearing on this matter for February 10, 2009.

The parties are in the process of negotiating a settlement regarding the outstanding complaint. Therefore, the Hearing Officer finds that the hearing scheduled for February 10, 2009 should be continued to a date to be determined.
