## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On November 5, 2008, Sue Vanicek, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS) (hereinafter "Complainant") of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) filed a Complaint against Granite Telecommunications, LLC, Quincy, Massachusetts (hereinafter "Respondent") alleging that Respondent failed to timely file with the Commission, its Quarterly Report due October 15, 2008, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-459(2)(Cum. Supp. 2006).

Subsequent to the Complaint, Complainant was informed that Respondent does not provide wireless service in Nebraska. Since Respondent does not provide wireless service, Respondent is not required to submit a quarterly report to the Commission pursuant to § 86-459(2). Therefore, the Complaint should be dismissed.

The Commission finds that the Complaint should be dismissed against the Respondent. Respondent is released from any further proceedings in relation to Application No. 911-030.13.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Complaint in Application No. 911-030.13, is hereby dismissed.
