On September 30, 2008, Sue Vanicek, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS) (hereinafter "Complainant") of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) filed a Complaint against Cricket Communications (hereinafter "Respondent") alleging that Respondent failed to file its wireless E911 remittance worksheets or remittance payments to the NTIPS department for **April, 2008** pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-442 et seq. (Cum. Supp. 2006).

The Complaint was sent to Respondent via certified mail return receipt requested. Respondent received the complaint on or about October 2, 2008. Respondent has not yet responded to the complaint. The Commission finds that the matter should be set for hearing on **January 6, 2009 at 1:30 p.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska.
