OPINION AND FINDINGS

On April 7, 2015, Sue Vanicek, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS) of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) (hereinafter "Complainant") filed а Complaint Raleigh, Bandwidth.com, Inc., North Carolina (hereinafter "Respondent"), alleging that Respondent failed to file its wireless E911 remittance worksheets or remittance payments to the NTIPS department for April, 2013, May, 2013, June, 2013, August, 2013, September, 2013, October, November, 2013, December, 2013, January, 2014, February, 2014, March, 2014, April, 2014, May, 2014, June, 2014, July, 2014, August, 2014, September, 2014, October, 2014 and November, 2014 pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-442 et seq. (2008 Supp.).

Since the filing of the complaint, Respondent has filed the appropriate worksheets and/or payments and has informed the Commission that steps are being taken to ensure that future filings will be made on a timely basis. Additionally, Respondent has requested a waiver of fines and fees. Pursuant to Commission policy, Respondent is entitled to a one-time waiver. Respondent is on notice that should it fail to timely make future filings, additional administrative fines and costs may be imposed.

The Commission finds that the one-time waiver should be approved and that the Complaint should be dismissed against Respondent. Respondent is released from any further proceedings in relation to Application No. 911-033.14.
