OPINION AND FINDINGS

Rev. Stat. § 86-442 et seq.

Respondent has filed the appropriate worksheets and/or payments. Since the filing of the Complaint, Respondent has signed a stipulation agreeing to the payment of a civil penalty and administrative costs.
