BY THE COMMISSION:

On or about July 9, 2012, Johnson County filed a request for funding to upgrade existing Phase II 911 equipment at a cost of \$66,384.00. Johnson County intends to use enhanced wireless 911 funds to pay up to sixty-six percent (66%) of the costs based upon the PSAPs' filed wireless call volumes.

Therefore, Johnson County is requesting to use \$40,136.40 of its enhanced wireless 911 funding, representing less than 66% of the total costs.

The Wireless Enhanced 911 Advisory Board considered the request at its July 16, 2012 meeting and recommended the request be approved.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) adopted the permanent cost model to administer funding for public safety answering points for the implementation and provision of Enhanced Wireless 911 service under Docket No. 911-019/PI-118

Based upon the request for funding, supporting documentation, and in consideration of the recommendation of the Advisory Board, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the costs requested are eligible under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-465 as costs have been incurred or will be incurred for the purchase, installation, maintenance or operation of telecommunications equipment and telecommunications services required for the provision of enhanced wireless 911 service.

Based upon the above, the Commission finds that funding request for Johnson County should be approved in the amount of **\$40,136.40.**

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the funding request for Johnson County is hereby approved, in part, as set forth herein in the amount of **\$40,136.40**.
