OPINION AND FINDINGS

On June 22, 2010, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) entered an order approving funding for Johnson County pursuant to Docket No. 911-019/PI-118. The deadline for the filing of all applications for funding was April 23, 2010.

Due to a clerical error, the original amount allocated to Johnson County was misstated as \$29,097.00 and should have been \$29,097.45. As a result the final amount approved after the deduction for the late-filed application, should have been \$26,672.66.

Based upon the above, the Commission finds that the June 22, 2010 order should be corrected to reflect the correct amount originally allocated to the county of \$29,097.45 and the proper amount approved of \$26,672.66.

The remainder of the June 22, 2010 order remains unchanged and in full effect.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the June 22, 2010 order should be corrected to reflect the correct amount originally allocated to the county of \$29,097.45 and the proper amount approved of \$26,672.66.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the remainder of the June 22, 2010 order remains unchanged and in full effect.
