O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On or about February 23, 2010, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) entered an order approving in part the City of Lincoln's funding request for equipment and software in the amount of **\$619,480.00** representing 68% of the amount requested reflecting the average percentage of wireless calls received over the previous twelve (12) months. The funds were to be advanced from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund (Fund) and a monthly amount deducted from the City of Lincoln's monthly allocation over a five-year period once installation was complete.

On or about March 18, 2011, the City of Lincoln filed a request with the Commission that it withdraw its earlier funding request and indicating that the City intends to proceed differently with the upgrade of its 911 equipment and software. Therefore, the City will be submitting a new funding request and will not require the previously approved funds.

The Commission finds that the previously approved funds in the amount of **\$619,480.00** should be released to the available funds for disbursement through the permanent funding mechanism.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the previously approved funds in the amount of **\$619,480.00** should be released to the available funds for disbursement through the permanent funding mechanism.
