OPINION AND FINDINGS

On or about March 30, 2010, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened the above-mentioned docket, on its own motion, seeking to administer funding for public safety answering points for the implementation and provision of Enhanced Wireless 911 service pursuant to the permanent funding mechanism approved under Docket No. 911-019/PI-118.

On May 27, 2015, the Commission entered an order approving Boone County's funding request less \$9,188.74 in pre-existing costs. Subsequent to entering the order, it was determined that Boone County did not receive an advance for the 2014-15 funding year, nor is the county requesting an advance for the 2015-16 funding year. Therefore, the Commission finds that an order nunc pro tunc should be entered to amend the May 27, 2015 order as follows:

"On April 15, 2015, Boone County filed its application for funding with the Commission pursuant to Docket No. 911-019/PI-118. Boone County serves Boone County and some residents in Platte, Nance and Greeley Counties. Boone County is eligible for funding in the amount of up to \$48,909.24 for the 2015-16 funding year....

No prior funding commitments exist.

Based upon the above, the Commission finds that the funding request for Boone County in the amount of up to \$48,909.24 should be approved consistent with the allocation determined in Docket 911-019/PI-118 paid in monthly installments of \$4,446.29 over eleven months....
