OPINION AND FINDINGS

On April 15, 2011, the City of Norfolk (Norfolk) filed its application for funding with the Commission pursuant to Docket No. 911-019/PI-118. On June 28, 2011, the Commission entered an order approving funding for Norfolk in the amount of \$74,838.16. Subsequent to entering the order, it was determined that the funding amount to be set aside was incorrect. Therefore, the Commission finds that an order nunc pro tunc should be entered to correct the error as follows:

"Norfolk has indicated that it anticipates using the funding provided for the following purposes: equipment upgrade, CAD system mapping software, and Qwest 911 costs, and plans to set aside 63% of its funding for future equipment and software upgrades and purchases."

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that an order nunc pro tunc to correct the errors set forth herein should be entered.
