OPINION AND FINDINGS

On or about March 30, 2010, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened the above-captioned docket, on its own motion, seeking to administer funding for wireless service providers for the implementation and provision of Enhanced Wireless 911 service pursuant to the permanent funding mechanism approved under Docket No. 911-019/PI-118. On June 16, 2015, the Commission entered an order allocating up to \$168,131.00 for US Cellular for the 2015-2016 funding year.

Due to a clerical error, the fourth paragraph of the June 16, 2015 order did not include the updated filing deadlines for a wireless service provider to submit its supporting documentation for eligible expenses to the Commission as approved in the Commission's order dated September 4, 2013.¹ Therefore, the Commission finds that an order nunc pro tunc should be entered to replace the fourth paragraph of the June 16, 2015 order as follows:

"Pursuant to Docket 911-019/PI-118, expenses for which reimbursement is sought must have been incurred during the current funding year and must be consistent with the expenses identified in US Cellular's application. Documentation supporting eligible expenditures should be submitted by the 7th of the month in order to receive payment by the end of the month. Payment will be made no later than the end of the month following the receipt of the request, as long as proper documentation is received with the request in a timely manner. All wireless service providers are subject to audit."

Additionally, the Commission finds that the second paragraph of the "ORDER" section should also be replaced as follows:

"IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that US Cellular request funds by filing documentation supporting eligible expenditures by the 7th of the month in order to receive payment by the end of the month."

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that an order nunc pro tunc to correct its June 16, 2015 order be entered as set forth herein.
