On May 4, 2010, the Nebraska Public Service Commission opened the present docket, on its own motion, seeking to investigate and establish standards and guidelines for Geographic Information Systems (GIS) Data necessary for the provision of Enhanced Wireless 911 Service.

The Commission sought comment on a variety of issues related to technical standards for the creation and maintenance of GIS data. Comments were filed by the Chief Information Officer for the State of Nebraska, NITC GIS Council, GIS Workshop, GeoComm, and Plant CML.
