## BY THE COMMISSION:

The Nebraska Public Service Commission opens the present docket on its own motion, seeking to investigate funding for costs for the development of certain Geographical Information Systems (GIS) Data relating to the provision of Enhanced Wireless 911 Service.

On or about October 15, 2012, Douglas County filed a request for funding seeking \$150,000 for the development of an address point layer for its GIS data. Washington County filed a similar request in the amount of \$29,984.00. The Commission entered orders Docket Nos. 911-042.38 911-042.49 in and approving the requests, in part, allowing Washington and Douglas Counties to utilize Enhanced Wireless 911 funds for the costs of the development the address point layer. However, the orders stated that the present investigation should be opened to determine whether the Commission should provide funding beyond the allocations provided to the PSAPs through the 911-SAM for the costs to develop an address point layer to the GIS data.

Therefore the Commission seeks comment on whether funding beyond the allocations provided to the PSAPs through the 911-SAM should be made available for the costs to develop a statewide address point layer for GIS data. Interested parties providing comment should include justification for their stated position and to the extent available the necessary steps and estimated costs involved in the development of the data.
