BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 4, 2013, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) opened the present docket on its own motion, seeking to conduct a study to examine issues surrounding the statewide implementation of next-generation 911 funded through the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund as required by LB 595 [2013].

In order to ensure the independence and timeliness of the next-generation 911 study, the Commission secured the services of an independent third party consultant to conduct the study. The Commission received the initial study from the consultant on January 31, 2014. On February 3, 2014, the Commission issued an Order¹ inviting interested parties to review the initial study and identify any factual errors that should be corrected on or before February 18, 2014. Timely comments were received by or on behalf of GeoComm, Inc., Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC and United Telephone of the West d/b/a CenturyLink, N.E. Colorado Cellular, Inc., d/b/a Viaero Wireless, the Nebraska Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, and CTIA-The Wireless Association. The final study was received by the Commission on or about March 7, 2014, and delivered to the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee of the Nebraska Legislature on March 11, 2014.

The Commission finds that all actions relating to the preparation, review and delivery of the study have been completed. Therefore, the above-captioned docket should be closed.
