BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 27, 2016, I entered an order providing interested persons time to object to the release of information included in the Douglas County Nebraska 911 Assessment Report ("Report"). I found that any objection to the release of any portion of the Report which discloses information believed to be filed under seal pursuant to the Protective Order must be filed in writing by an interested person on or before **June 2, 2016**. I further found that all supporting documentation relevant to the objection must be filed on or before **June 7, 2016**.

On June 1, 2016, counsel for Douglas County 911 Communications (DC 911) requested an enlargement of time to object to the release of any portion of the Report by Tuesday, **June 7, 2016**, and provide supporting documentation by Friday, **June 10, 2016**. In support of this Motion, DC 911 stated it was necessary to have additional time for DC 911 to review the Report, given the length and technical complexity of the Report. In addition, undersigned counsel was scheduled to be out of the office from June 2, 2016 until June 6, 2016.

In consideration of the Motion filed by DC 911, I find it should be granted and additional time provided as requested. Objections to the release of any portion of the Report must be filed by **June 7, 2016**, and supporting documentation must be filed on or before **June 10, 2016**.
