BY THE COMMISSION:

The Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission), on its own motion, opens the above-captioned investigation into the adequacy of wireless services in the Lake Wa Con-Da area of Cass County, Nebraska.

Lake Wa Con-Da sits in a valley near Union and Murray, Nebraska and the Missouri River, which serves as the state line between Nebraska and Iowa. Residents in the area have reported issues with inconsistent wireless telephone service and difficulties contacting 911. In addition, the Commission has received reports that 911 calls from the area that are routed to an Iowa PSAP are not always transferred to the appropriate Nebraska PSAP.

The Commission has been working with the wireless industry and area PSAPs to find a solution, as the inability to contact 911 during an emergency is a serious public safety issue which must be resolved. Several options have been discussed that should be explored in more detail.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that a hearing should be scheduled in order to determine the best course of action to alleviate this public safety issue. Hearing on this matter shall be set for August 24, 2016 at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, Suite 300, Lincoln, Nebraska.
