BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered July 9, 2002, the Commission granted Keith County funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund as described in Keith County's written request for funding, filed June 20, 2002. After entering its order, the Commission became aware that Keith County had made a calculation error in completing its original written request for funding.

By amended request for funding filed July 15, 2002, Keith County seeks initial costs of \$11,959.80 and recurring costs of \$1,322.20 per month to implement and provide enhanced wireless 911 service for each of the wireless carriers listed in our original order. Initial costs are for database upgrades, trunking infrastructure and purchase, installation, and testing of circuits for enhanced wireless 911. Recurring costs are monthly fees for database management and for operation and maintenance of trunks and circuits.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Commission finds that its order of July 9, 2002, in the above-captioned docket should be modified by approving Keith County for the amounts set forth in the preceding paragraph.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Commission's order in this docket is modified as described herein.
