BY THE COMMISSION:

By written request for funding received October 10, 2003, Scottsbluff County, Scottsbluff, sought funding from the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund for expenses of implementing and providing enhanced wireless 911 service. That application was granted on October 15, 2003, in Application No. PSAP-031.

On January 13, 2005, the Commission received an application from Scottsbluff County for the costs of Sprint to add additional circuits to the Scottsbluff selective router tandem related to Viaero Wireless. Scottsbluff County seeks non-recurring costs of \$50.00 and recurring monthly costs of \$20.16.

Scottsbluff County entered into a service agreement with Sprint for enhanced wireless 911 equipment and services. A copy of the agreement is attached to the original request for funding. In the agreement, Scottsbluff County authorized the Nebraska Public Service Commission to remit all payments for enhanced wireless 911 service to Sprint.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

This request for funding is being processed pursuant to $\underline{\text{Neb}}$. $\underline{\text{Rev}}$. $\underline{\text{Stat}}$. $\underline{\text{SS}}$ 86-2201 to 86-2214, 291 Neb. Admin. Code, Chapter 1, Section 5, and Progression Order No. 4 in Commission Docket No. 911-001 entered April 23, 2002.

Costs requested are eligible under $\underline{\text{Neb}}$. $\underline{\text{Rev}}$. $\underline{\text{Stat}}$. § 86-2210 (2001 Supp.). All costs have been incurred or will be incurred for the purchase, installation, maintenance and operation of telecommunications equipment and telecommunications services required for the provision of enhanced wireless 911 service.

Scottsbluff County has submitted an implementation plan in compliance with Commission Docket No. 911-001.

Because Scottsbluff County authorized Sprint to receive all payments on its behalf for wireless enhanced 911, the Commission further finds that payment should be remitted to Sprint upon

invoice. Only invoices that comport with the approved costs in this order will be paid. Recurring costs requested for partial months must be prorated.

Based upon the request for funding and supporting documentation, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request for funding should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Scottsbluff County's request for funding should be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon invoice from Sprint, the Commission shall remit to Sprint, amount that comports with this order.
