O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On January 11, 2006, the Commission entered an order granting the application of Perkins County PSAP, Grant, seeking approval of funding for GIS data. On page one of that order the Commission detailed the costs that were being approved for funding approval. The Commission inadvertently stated that costs associated with maintenance of the GIS data and MSAG information was the amount of \$27,000 for a five-year period, when the actual costs for the five-year period should have been stated as \$19,700. The Commission enters this order nunc pro tunc to correct this error.

The purpose of an order nunc pro tunc is to correct the record which has been made so that it will truly record the action taken which, through inadvertence or mistake, was not truly recorded. Interstate Printing Co. v. Dept. of Revenue, 236 Neb. 110, 459 N.W.2d 519 (1990). Clerical errors may be corrected by an order nunc pro tunc, but not judicial errors. Larson v. Bedke, 211 Neb. 247, 318 N.W.2d 253 (1982).

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the order be corrected to show the dollar amount be changed from \$27,000 to \$19,700 for costs associated with maintenance of GIS data and MSAG information for a five-year period.
