OPINION AND FINDINGS

The complaint in caption seeks an order revoking the intrastate operating authority of each of the named defendants for failing to file an access flow-through toll plan pursuant to Commission Order C-1628/NUSF, Progression Order No. 5, and in part, Neb. Rev. Stat. sec. 75-609(3) (1999 Slip Law).

On September 14, 1999, Allnet Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Communications Service (Frontier) was granted an extension in filing its access flow-through plan with the Commission. Frontier subsequently satisfied the filing requirement on October 27, 1999, and should be removed from this proceeding.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Allnet Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Communications Service be, and it is hereby, dismissed from the departmental complaint.
