## BY THE COMMISSION:

- 1. On July 24, 2001, the Commission opened this docket to seek comment on how it should verify that all federal high-cost support will be used for its intended purpose in compliance with 47 C.F.R. § 54.314. Parties wishing to provide comments were permitted to do so on or before August 10, 2001.
- 2. Four parties submitted comments: United Telephone Company of the West d/b/a Sprint, TCA, Inc. Telecom Consulting Associates, Citizens Telephone Company of Nebraska, and an association of rural independent companies1. Each party proposed that verification could be achieved by self-certification to the Commission.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS


The Commission finds that a self-certification process would be sufficient to verify that all federal high-cost support will be used for its intended purpose in compliance with 47 C.F.R. § 54.314. Each rural ILEC (and/or ETC within the service area) should certify that it intends to use any federal universal service support only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and/or service for which the support is intended in accordance with section 254(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, as amended. Such certification should be in the form of an affidavit signed by a corporate officer and duly notarized. The Commission reserves the right to independently verify the accuracy of such certification.

The Commission also finds that it should issue a subsequent decision in this proceeding approving any affidavit certifications that have been properly completed and timely filed.
