BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 15, 2007, the Commission entered an order in the above-captioned dockets establishing annual filing requirements for each eligible telecommunications carrier and Nebraska eligible telecommunications carrier. These filings are intended to be used for purposes of verifying to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) whether all federal high-cost support will be used for its intended purpose, pursuant to 47 C.F.R § 54.314 and CC Docket No. $96-45^1$ and to further ensure all state universal service high-cost support is being used for their intended purpose.

The order required that the filings be made no later than June 1. Based on the fact that carriers may need additional time to gather the required information during this first year, the hearing officer hereby extends the deadline for the 2007 annual filing to **June 15, 2007**.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Hearing Officer that the deadline for filing with the NTIPS Department of the 2007 information regarding high-cost funding is extended to **June 15, 2007**.
