On August 21, 2001, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) entered an order initiating the above-captioned docket. In that order, the Commission identified issues for comment and set forth a procedural schedule for the interested parties to file initial and reply comments. The Commission required reply comments to be filed on or before November 30, 2001. Subsequent to that order, the Commission moved the time frame for filing initial comments back. Upon review of this time line, the Commission finds that it is appropriate to extend the deadline for the submission of reply comments back to December 14, 2001. Therefore, all interested parties have until 5:00 p.m. on December 14, 2001, to file reply comments.
