## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On July 12, 2016 the Commission opened this docket, initiating a show cause proceeding against Legacy Long Distance International, Inc. ("Legacy Long Distance") (NE000192) for its failure to timely file an audit with the Commission. Legacy Long Distance was required to file its audit with the Commission on July 1, 2016. It filed its audit with the Commission on July 25, 2016.

Legacy Long Distance and the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety (NTIPS) Director have entered into a stipulation resolving the allegations, and the company has paid its fine. Upon review of the stipulation, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that it should be approved and the Show Cause proceeding should be dismissed.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Show Cause proceeding initiated against Legacy Long Distance on July 12, 2016 be, and is hereby dismissed.
