OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 18, 2004, the Commission opened the above-captioned docket initiating a show cause proceeding against certain carriers for failing to timely file their remittance audit in accordance with NUSF-1, Progression Order No. 7 as expanded and extended by NUSF-33, Progression Order No. 1 and Title 291, Chapter 10, Rule 003.05 of the Nebraska Administrative Code.

A show cause hearing was held on March 23, 2004. NE Colorado Cellular, Inc. d/b/a Viaero Wireless (Viaero), appeared through its local counsel, Mr. Loel Brooks. The remittance audit and a stipulated civil penalty of \$3,300.00 have been received by the NUSF Department and the parties are therefore requesting dismissal pursuant to the terms of the stipulation.
