OPINION AND FINDINGS

By Complaint dated April 25, 2007, Jeffrey L. Pursley, Director of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department ("NTIPS") Department of the Nebraska Commission ("Commission") Service (hereinafter "Complainant") filed Complaint against Gold а (hereinafter "Respondent") alleging Telemanagement, Respondent failed to file the required remittance worksheets or remittance payments to the NTIPS Department by the 15th day following the end of the remittance period for the 4th Quarter, 2005; 4th Quarter, 2006; and 1st Quarter, 2007 remittance periods.

A copy of the Complaint was mailed to the Respondent, by certified mail, on May 16, 2007. On January 15, 2008, the Commission entered a Show Cause Order seeking administrative fines and revocation of the Respondent's certificate of authority and setting this matter for hearing. A hearing was held in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska on February 12, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. Nichole Underhill entered an appearance on behalf of the Commission staff. The Respondent failed to enter an appearance.

On March 20, 2008 the Commission entered an order sustaining the complaint against the Respondent and assessed a penalty in the amount of Five Thousand dollars (\$5,000.00),

giving the Respondent sixty (60) days to remit the adjudged penalties and fees or the Commission would seek revocation of Respondent's certificate of authority. A copy of the order sustaining the complaint was mailed to the Respondent on March 26, 2008. A copy of this order shall be mailed to the Respondent via certified mail.

To date, Respondent has failed to remit the adjudged penalties and fees. In consideration thereof, the Commission finds that the Respondent should be ordered to show cause as to why its certificate of public convenience and necessity should not be revoked. Furthermore, the Commission finds that a hearing should be scheduled on this matter.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Gold Line Telemanagement, is ordered to show cause as to why its certificate of necessity and convenience should not be revoked for failure to remit the adjudged penalties and fees for failure to resolve the delinquency with the NTIPS Department.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this order shall be mailed to Gold Line Telemanagement, via certified mail.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that hearing on this matter is scheduled for **August 26, 2008, at 11:30 a.m.** at the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, Suite 300, Lincoln, Nebraska.
