## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By Complaint dated December 3, 2003 Jeffrey L. Pursley, of the Nebraska Universal Service Director Fund Department of the Nebraska Public Service Commission (hereinafter "Complainant") (Commission) filed a TransCommunications, Inc. (hereinafter "Respondent") alleging that Respondent failed to file the required remittance worksheets or remittance payments to the NUSF Department by the 15th day following the end of the remittance period.

A copy of the Complaint was mailed to the Respondent, by certified mail, on December 8, 2003.

A Hearing on the Complaint was held on March 8, 2005. No appearances were entered for the Respondent. During that time, it was made known to the Commission that Respondent was in bankruptcy. Respondent filed a Chapter 7 bankruptcy petition in July of 2005. The certificate of public convenience and necessity held by Respondent was revoked in late 2005 for its failure to file an annual report. Accordingly, Respondent no longer does any business in the State of Nebraska. At this time, the Commission finds the Complaint should be dismissed.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the above-captioned complaint be and it is hereby dismissed.
